

French syntax—cut out the individual words and mix up the order. Ask pupils to rearrange the words in the correct order to make a grammatically correct sentence. You could give one sentence at a time, or add challenge by giving many sentences together and seeing which combinations your pupils put together (and if they are grammatically correct).
